- Encourage parental participation and support
- Provide positive feedback to members

- Ability to organize information and materials
- · Ability to work with minimal supervision from professional staff
- Ability to educate youth while nurturing positive self-esteem, decision-making, responsibility and leadership in youth
- The ability to communicate effectively with youth, parents, and other adult volunteers
- A sincere interest in sharing knowledge & skills with youth in an informal educational setting
