GENERAL PURPOSE:

To work with youth in an after-school setting to start and complete a clothing project

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead a group of 10-15 youth in an after-school classroom setting to develop youth interest in clothing construction
- To help youth complete projects for competitive shows
- To help coordinate additional learning activities

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must undergo the Kentucky 4-H volunteer application and screening process and be accepted as a volunteer
- Must have an interest in community child development
- Must be willing to receive training on topic of interest
- Must be willing to attend regularly scheduled meetings
- Must provide own transportation to meetings
- Must follow school administration basic guidelines
- Must use recommended 4-H learning practices

- The opportunity to work with community youth and provide positive support
- Receive all expense paid training with other community volunteers
- Will receive training for state and national 4-H events
