GENERAL PURPOSE:

To teach CHARACTER COUNTS!sm curriculum to youth

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach curriculum
- Be committed to young people and their development at all times
- Coordinate and conduct educational activities related to the character education topic of the month
- Ask teachers to follow up on related educational experiences throughout the month
- When appropriate encourage youth to become involved in other 4-H youth educational programs.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must complete the Volunteer Application process and be approved by the Youth
- Protection/Risk Management Committee
- A sincere interest in working with youth by classroom age groups K-8th
- The ability to provide information and motivate youth while nurturing positive self esteem, decision making, responsibility, and leadership in the youth
- A sincere interest in sharing knowledge and experiences and skills with youth and adults in classroom settings.
- Ability to work and communicate effectively in a verbal form
- Ability to work effectively with minimal supervision from professional staff
- A willingness to become familiar with and work with the philosophy and guidelines of the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service, Ky 4-H program and county 4-H program
