GENERAL PURPOSE:

Work with local event committee members to ensure that judges have been secured

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collaborate with each event committee to identify perspective judges. Event committees will include: Talk Meet, Demo's, Posters, Record Books, Variety Show and Rally Day/County Fair
- Follow-up with committee members 1 week prior to event to verify judges have been secured
- Report to 4-H agent that judges have been confirmed

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must complete the Volunteer Application process and be approved by the Youth
- Protection/Risk Management Committee
- Access to telephone
- Ability to communicate with others

- Professionals will be available to consult with volunteers on a one to one basis
- Opportunities for professionals to listen to volunteers ideas to help improve the 4-H program will be available
- Recognition and awards will be given to volunteers
