POSITION TITLE:

Livestock Show Superintendent

TIME REQUIRED / DURATION OF APPOINTMENT:

- Two hours each month for 12 months
- Five eight hours the day of the show

LOCATION:

At home, extension office, county fairgrounds

GENERAL PURPOSE:

To coordinate livestock show(s) at the county fair. To work with the livestock show committee to plan and organize beef, dairy, sheep, hogs and/or goat shows.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend orientation
- Create and/or maintain database for volunteer information
- Meet with livestock show committee to determine details of livestock shows
- Work with county fair board and Extension Professionals
- Recruit judges for livestock shows
- Recruit volunteers to work the livestock shows
- Organize technical equipment & supplies on show day

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must complete the Kentucky 4-H Volunteer Application processes and be approved by the Youth Protection/Risk Management Committee
- Provide own transportation to meetings and activities
- Self-starter: must be able to work with minimal supervision from professional staff
- Effective communication skills
- A sincere interest in working with Extension staff, volunteers, parents and youth
- Understanding and knowledge of livestock

- Receive intrinsic and extrinsic rewards at volunteer recognition events
- Volunteer development opportunities
