POSITION TITLE:

County Extension Homemaker President

TIME REQUIRED:

- Terms for County president are designated by local council's constitution and bylaws.
- · President is expected to conduct regular council meetings
- Additional time as needed for special called meetings, preparation for meetings, and implementation of homemaker projects and activities

LOCATION:

County Extension Office, virtual meetings, or community sites

GENERAL PURPOSE:

Unite the county homemaker association and develop enthusiastic leadership with local Kentucky Extension Homemaker Association (KEHA) members. Demonstrate a willingness to assume responsibilities to further strengthen, develop, coordinate and extend adult education in Family and Consumer Sciences. Conduct and promote the work of the state organization.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Preside over County Extension Homemaker business, annual and special meetings
- Work with county officers and chairmen for the benefit of the county organization
- Appoint all special and standing committees
- Attend area homemaker council meetings; represent county organization and share area news with county members
- Make a report of county activities for area annual meeting and serve as voting delegate
- Promote KEHA and its related contests and activities

- Applicants must complete volunteer application and screening process
- Provide own transportation to meetings and activities
- Must be a KEHA member
- Must have served or be serving as club President or President-Elect in the county Extension Homemaker Association
